



Please consult your Design Associate for current specifications.

## INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

- > This product must be installed by a professional licensed contractor.
- Inspect this product to ensure you have all the parts required for proper installation.
- Use only a strap wrench or protected/smooth-jaw wrench on any finished surface.
- The use of certain plumber's putty may stain stone or tile surfaces.

#### **SPOUT INSTALLATION:**

- See Figure 1. for Steps 1-3.
- 1. Remove the NUT, METAL WASHER, RUBBER WASHER & PLASTIC SPACER from the bottom of the SPOUT SHANK.
- 2. Insert the SPOUT and SPOUT SHANK through the hole on the mounting surface making sure the RUBBER GASKET is underneath the spout.
- 3. Re-install the PLASTIC SPACER, RUBBER WASHER, METAL WASHER & NUT (in that order). Tighten the NUT to secure the spout.



#### HANDLE INSTALLATION:

- See Figure 2. for Steps 4-7.
- 4. Remove the TRIM CONNECTOR from the VALVE BODY.
- 5. Thread the NUT as far down as possible on the VALVE BODY, moving the METAL WASHER, RUBBER WASHER & PLASTIC SPACER along with it.
- 6. From under the mounting surface, place the VALVE BODY with mounting hardware through the hole in the deck. From above the deck, thread the TRIM ADAPTER down on valve body until it stops.
- 7. Hand tighten NUT to secure the TRIM CONNECTOR to the deck. Note: This will allow for handle alignment.



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# INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

10. Verify the handle alignment and then tighten the NUT, below the surface, to secure this assembly.




- First, thread the male end of the OUTLET HOSE into the SPOUT SHANK, then thread the female hex end of the OUTLET HOSE into the side outlet of the VALVE BODY.





12. Attach SUPPLY KIT [SOLD SEPARATELY] to inlet on VALVE BODY, using the supply nut.	20. Close the drain and fill the sink with water to make sure the drain stopper and gasket operates and seals properly.
<ol> <li>Repeat steps 4-12 to install the second handle assembly.</li> </ol>	21. Re-install the flow restricting aerator.

15. Set the DRAIN FLANGE in the drain hole using putty or a clear adhesive silicone depending on the mounting surface material.*	<ul> <li>Putty contains oils and can cause permanent discoloration on certain materials such as marble, granite and any porous surface.</li> </ul>
16. Making sure the RUBBER GASKET and PLASTIC WASHER are on the LOWER DRAIN BODY, thread the LOWER DRAIN BODY onto the DRAIN FLANGE. Securely tighten the LOWER DRAIN BODY, making sure the RUBBER GASKET makes a full seal on the underside of the lavatory. Putty or a clear adhesive silicone may be used to ensure a water tight seal between the RUBBER GASKET and lavatory.*	
17. Attach the TAILPIECE to the LOWER DRAIN BODY using the DRAIN NUT, making sure the RUBBER WASHER is in between the LOWER DRAIN BODY and TAILPIECE.

INSPECT THE INSTALLATION:	
<ol> <li>Remove the flow restricting AERATOR using the tool provided, then carefully open the hot and cold valves to flush out any debris in the supply lines. See Figure 1.</li> </ol>
