INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

- Inspect the product to ensure you have all the parts required for proper installation. Product is sold partially assembled but shown fully disassembled for illustrative and service purposed only.
- Use only a strap wrench or protected/smooth-jaw wrench on any finished surface.
- The use of certain plumber's putty may stain stone or tile surfaces.

ROUGH-IN:

- Determine the ideal location for the HANDSHOWER and rough-in a well supported 1/2" NPT MALE NIPPLE ⁺ (not supplied) of appropriate length.
- Adequate blocking in the wall is recommended for mounting the HANDSHOWER BAR using the 1-3/16" length WOOD SCREWS provided.
- DRYWALL ANCHORS, intended for use in a typical 1/2" drywall installation, are provided for situations where blocking is not installed.

SUPPLY ELBOW INSTALLATION:

Install a 1/2" NPT nipple (not supplied) of appropriate length and ensure the front face of the nipple protrudes 5/8" [16mm] from the finished wall. See Figure - 01.

Slide the ESCUTCHEON and O-RING down the SUPPLY ELBOW then thread and securely tighten the SUPPLY ELBOW onto the NPT NIPPLE.

BAR INSTALLATION:

See Figure - 03 for Steps 3 - 8.



- Loosen the SET SCREWS on the ESCUTCHEONS using a 1.5mm hex key then slide the ESCUTCHEONS up the POSTS to expose the MOUNTING PLATES.
- The SCREWS on the front of the ESCUTCHEONS are aesthetic only and do not serve any mechanical purpose and should not be removed.
- 4. Dry-fit the BAR to the finished wall and mark the mounting hole locations making sure the BAR is level and the MOUNTING PLATES are at a 24" [610mm] on-center spread.
- 5. Unthread the SCREWS holding the MOUNTING PLATES to the POSTS using a 3mm hex key and remove the PLATES.
- 6. Attach the MOUNTING PLATES to the finished wall using the marks made in Step 4 with the ANCHORS and SCREWS provided.
- Insert the POSTS into the MOUNTING PLATES then thread and securely tighten the SCREWS with a 3mm hex key.
- 8. Slide the ESCUTCHEONS down the POSTS until they contact the finished wall and align them with the SET SCREW either on the left or right side. Securely tighten the SET SCREW using a 1.5mm hex key.

FINISH AND INSPECT THE INSTALLATION:

- 9. Connect the hex end of the HOSE to the SUPPLY ELBOW then turn on the water supply and a diverter or wall valve (sold separately) to flush out any debris in the supply line.
- 10. Inspect all connections for leaks and turn the water off.
- 11. Slide the ESCUTCHEON down the SUPPLY ELBOW until it contacts the finished wall.

INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

- 12. Connect the conical end of the HOSE to the HANDSHOWER then place it into the adjustable HOOK.
- NOTE: A FLOW REGULATING CHECK VALVE is located in the inlet of the HANDSHOWER.
- 13. To adjust the HOOK:
 - Height: Loosen the HANDLE then slide to the desired height and tighten the HANDLE. See Figure 04.
 - Angle: The HOOK is held in place with friction and can be rotated to the desired angle. See Figure 04.
